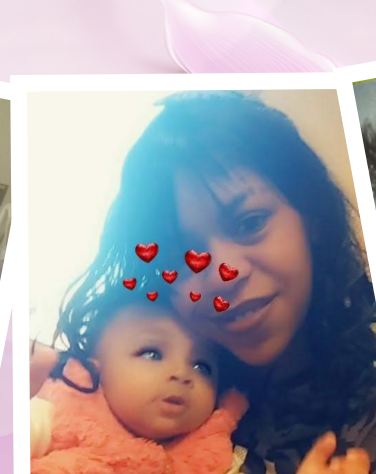

Gwen's battle ended April 2, 2020 with her daughter Nichole Scovil, Carlos Hicks, Mario Hicks, and family by





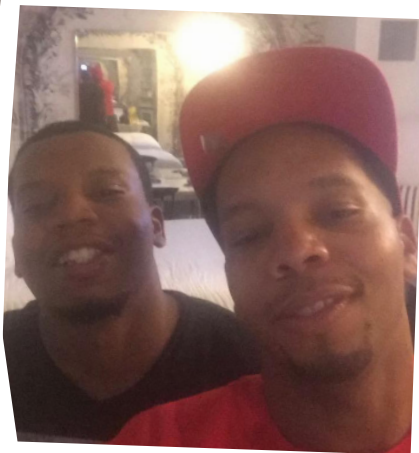
Memories
